02. MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Entrance requirements for VIHS are based on GCE/IGCSE O'Level & SSC results. Please note that grades "A*", "A", "B" and "C" are passes at O'Level and that VIHS will only consider O'Levels taken in the last two years. i.e for this year's admission, O'Levels taken after Oct/Nov 2018 will be considered.

03. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The application forms can be collected from Villa International High School (VIHS) office during the admission period or downloaded from our website: www.vihs.edu.mv. The form should be returned within the allocated period along with the required documents, as specified on the application form.

** Note that applicants should have passes in a total of five (5) subjects at IGCSE, O/L and SSC in order to be eligible for MOE fee. If NOT, you can still study the subjects which you have a pass at O/L and IGCSE, for a monthly fee of MVR 2400/- , from 1st March 2020 to 31st June 2022. You must study at least 2 Edexcel A/Level subjects at VIHS.*

04. CHOOSING SUBJECTS TO STUDY AT VIHS:

COMPULSORY SUBJECTS:

- a) **IGCSE O/LEVEL ENGLISH:** This subject is compulsory for all students who failed in O Level/IGCSE English
b) **DHIVEHI & ISLAM:** Dhivehi and Islam will be taught for National HSC Syllabus and is **compulsory for all Maldivian students who gain admission under MOE sponsorship**. All students are required to follow the course and appear for the HSC exam at the end of the second year.

D. OPTIONAL SUBJECTS OFFERED TO ALL STUDENTS: Students may choose to study any ONE of the optional subjects offered below. However, we advise you to consider the following:

a) ENGLISH: VIHS offers Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) and Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) as options.

Students who achieved grade "A*" or "A" in IGCSE English may choose CPE. Students who have achieved "A*", "A" or "B" in GCE O/Level English may also opt for CPE.

CAE is offered for students who have achieved grades "B" and "C" in IGCSE English and "C" in GCE O/Level English. (* students with a "C" in IGCSE Core English cannot opt for CAE).

05. VIHS SCHOLARSHIPS

Villa International High School offers scholarships to the following categories of students:

Category-1: Brilliant Student Scholarships:

- a) Students who achieved 8 A/A*s in O/L will receive MVR 1000 per month for the duration of A/Level studies at VIHS. 20 places are available.
- b) Students who achieved 7A/A*s and 1B/1C will receive MVR 500 per month for the duration of A/Level studies at VIHS. 20 places are available.

Category-2: Subject Expert Scholarships:

- c) Achievers of "Top in the World from a Subject" from O/Level National Top Ten will receive MVR 500 per month for the duration of A/Level studies at VIHS. 5 places are available.

Category-3: Sports & Co Curricular Scholarships:

- d) Applicants who have won an Individual 1st place from an interschool or national competition/tournament listed in MoE activity calendar will receive MVR 500 per month for the duration of A/Level studies at VIHS. 5 places are available.

a. **Application & registration deadlines:**

- Applications are open from: 12th January to 20th February 2020.
- **Open Day: Friday 31st January 2020-** 4:00-6:00pm & 7:30-9:30 pm at Villa International High School. Applicants can visit VIHS, meet teachers and find out more about the subjects, clubs and associations and other opportunities offered at the school.
- Completed applications can be submitted to VIHS office between 9:00am-2.30pm of weekdays, starting from 19th January to 20th February 2020. Personal information form & uniform code for students who gain admission will be issued within 3 days of submitting the completed applications to VIHS office. **Students will be registered once the completed personal information forms are submitted.**
- Personal information forms must be submitted to school office latest by 2:00pm of 20th February 2020.
- Applications close by 2:30 pm of 20th February 2020.
- Selected students' list will be displayed on school notice board & website on: 24th February 2020.
- Class lists and orientation program schedule will be displayed on school notice board & website on: 25th February 2020.
